Watercolour Play for Beginners

From my experience, I know that it is better if you have this entire list of materials. If you are buying new, please get Artist quality paints—I use MaimeriBlu & Daniel Smith. Van Gogh is a more affordable range. Please use what you already have and fill the gaps from this list.

Paints colours:

- Yellow: 1x cool; 1x warm
- Red: 1x cool; 1x Burnt Sienna
- Blue: 1x cool; 1x warm AND
- Dark: Paynes Grey or similar

Painting Boards: 2 x Gatorboard, 1/4 (both or 1x 1/8 & 1/4) sheet paper size

Palette with deep wells and 2—4 mixing areas + a lid

Brushes: Pointed Mop OR 25mm Hake AND

Rounds #8 (x2) AND 1/2" Flat Taklon

Paper: *Artist quality is essential*—Baohong, Arches, Waterford

1 x sheet 300gsm Rough OR Pack 20 1/4 sheet Baohong

OR A4 300gsm pad (Arches)

Misc:

- Pencils 2B; Kneadable Eraser
- Sketchbook A5 or A4 for notes
- Masking Tape—good quality—18 or 25mm wide
- 2 x large Water Pots eg Yoghurt containers
